



COOP'S CORNER

HOW TO DRAW ... A FAST-MOVING CAR


Road & Track artist Coop teaches you to make it look like your drawing is speeding!




1. Let's start easy with a sloping rectangle and ovals for wheels. Use a pencil, because we're going to be doing a lot of erasing!




2. Give a rounded shape to the car's body and create depth for the wheels.




3. Color in the tires and add the roof.



4. Now add shapes for lights, window partitions, and a front grille!



5. Let's fill in the window and grille shapes for extra depth. Next, draw a curved "half T" line on the side of the car — it will create the illusion of a door. Lastly ... spoiler alert! Add a spoiler to give it a sporty look.



6. Time to floor it! Add burnout smoke from the tires and speed lines from the spoiler, roof, or wherever you want. There are no rules or speed limits where you're headed!
